



# **IIT Jammu, IIM Jammu ink MoU to collaborate, share resources to improve quality of education**

The Indian Institute of Technology Jammu (IIT) and the Indian Institute of Management (IIM) Jammu inked an MoU on Wednesday for collaborative excellence in teaching, research and placements, besides sharing of expertise and resources to improve the quality of education, officials said. The two pioneering institutions located in Jammu aim to collaborate in various parallels in order to churn out the best engineers and managers in the country, they added.

Teams from both the institutions got together at the IIT Jammu campus to discuss the future of the MoU, the officials said.

It was decided at the meeting that the collaboration will also work towards creating a "community engagement programme" dedicated to solving the problems of the region.

The scope of the MoU includes academic, research, administrative, and consultancy collaborations.

Faculty members will help students of both institutions with their academic expertise and research excellence. To this effect, the credit system and course options must be agreed upon individually, the officials said.

The two institutions will be sharing research and academic infrastructure besides other facilities agreed upon mutually from time to time, they added.

As far as placement collaboration is concerned, contacts of resource persons and organisations of IIT Jammu and IIM Jammu may be shared in an effort to improve placement scores of graduating students, the officials said.

JAMMU, Feb 10: The Indian Institute of Technology, Jammu (IIT Jammu) and Indian Institute of Management (IIM Jammu) today entered into an MoU to collaborate in various parallels in order to churn out the best engineers and managers in the country.

Teams from both the institutions got together at the IIT Jammu campus to discuss the future of the MoU.

The meeting was chaired by Directors of both the institutes who after a quick introduction from present members went on to have a very encouraging discussion on the bright prospects of this MoU. It was decided that this collaboration will also work towards creating a collaborative "community engagement programme" dedicated to solve the problems of the region.

A collaborative brochure of both the institutes was proposed to be created that will go on to highlight the infrastructure and offerings of both the institutions.

The scope of the MoU includes academic, research, administrative, and consultancy collaborations. IIT Jammu and IIM Jammu have agreed to work together on Academic, research, and consultancy collaborations, under which faculty members of both institutions will help students of both institutions with their aca-

demical expertise and research excellence.

Facilities like labs, library, and other academic infrastructure may be shared by both the institutions on a mutually agreed upon basis from time to time while international contacts of resource persons and organizations associated with IIT Jammu and IIM Jammu may be exchanged between the institutions.

Besides Placement collaboration, IIT Jammu and IIM Jammu have agreed to share banking facilities, Medical infrastructure and other campus facilities,

For the convenience of the children of faculty and staff of both the Institutes, it has been mutually agreed that a joint proposal shall be submitted to the Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS) for setting up a Kendriya Vidyalaya (KV) at Jagti in project mode.

"This collaboration is of utmost benefit to our students who will now graduate with technological excellence coupled with a strong understanding of management practices," said Prof. Manoj Singh Gaur, Director - IIT Jammu.

"The MoU is a great opportunity for both the institutions to share their expertise and resources and work collaboratively to improve the quality of education and provide the best to the students." Observed Prof B S Sahay, Director- IIM Jammu.

## औद्योगिक मांगों के मुताबिक ढाले जाएंगे आइटीआइ पाठ्यक्रम

जागरण संवाददाता, जम्मू : प्रिंसिपल सचिव कौशल विकास विभाग डा. असगर हसन समून ने बुधवार को अधिकारियों के साथ एक बैठक में कहा कि जम्मू-कश्मीर में आइटीआइ के पाठ्यक्रम को औद्योगिक मांगों के अनुरूप विकसित किया जाएगा। यही नहीं, औद्योगिक डिमांड के आधार पर नए पाठ्यक्रम भी शुरू किए जाएंगे। उन्होंने बताया कि वर्तमान समय में 52 सरकारी आइटीआइ और 34 प्राइवेट आइटीआइ में करीब 13 हजार युवाओं को इंजीनियरिंग ट्रेड, आर्किटेक्चर, ड्राफ्ट्समैन, टर्नर, इंस्ट्रूमेंट मेकेनिक, मेकेनिक मोटर व्हीकल और नान इंजीनियरिंग ट्रेड, कंप्यूटर, डाटा एंट्री, कंप्यूटर हार्डवेयर एंड नेटवर्किंग, डेस्कटॉप पब्लिशिंग,

डिजिटल में प्रशिक्षित किया जा रहा है। इसके अलावा फोटोग्राफी, ड्रेस मेकिंग और फैशन डिजाइनिंग का कोर्स भी करवाया जा रहा है। उनको बताया गया कि कई अल्प अवधि के पाठ्यक्रम भी युवाओं के लिए शुरू किए गए हैं जिसमें इलेक्ट्रिशियन, मोबाइल फोन हार्डवेयर, वेब डेवलपर, हैंडलूम वीवर कालीन, डीटीएच सेट टाप बाक्स इंस्टालेशन, सीए स्टोर तकनीशियन, रक्वैश, जूस, अचार प्रसंस्करण फल प्रसंस्करण, यात्रा सलाहकार, मधुमक्खी पालन, ट्रैक्टर आपरेटर, हेयर स्टाइलिस्ट, सौर पैनल तकनीशियन शामिल हैं। हाल ही में 24 आइटीआइ में 707 छात्रों के लिए इलेक्ट्रिशियन डोमेस्टिक, फील्ड एंड नेटवर्किंग, डेस्कटॉप पब्लिशिंग,

प्लंबिंग, मोबाइल फोन रिपेयर, एयर कंडीशनर रिपेयरिंग, टेलरिंग, फ्रंट आफिस एसोसिएट, ट्रेवल कंसल्टेंट, आटोमैटिक सर्विस टेक्नीशियन, पल्प प्रोसेसिंग के लिए तीन माह के कोर्स शुरू किए गए हैं, जिनका युवाओं को लाभ मिलेगा। समून ने बताया कि औद्योगिक प्रतिनिधियों ने नए एलसी, एसकेएडीए, स्टॉक की सूची, इंडक्शन मोटर्स, डीसी मोटर्स, ओएलटीसी मरम्मत व रखरखाव, आटो इलेक्ट्रिशियन और औद्योगिक सुरक्षा पाठ्यक्रम शुरू करने के सुझाव दिए हैं। मौके पर मिशन निदेशक कौशल मिशन, डा. सैयद आबिद रशीद शाह, निदेशक कौशल विकास सज्जाद हुसैन गनी और जेकेयूटी में उद्योगों के प्रतिनिधियों ने भी भाग लिया।
